Hello Panther Community –

Welcome back again! The halls of Caribbean School never feel the same without the voices of our children. We are anxious to see all of you on campus again but would like to make sure we all read the important information of this communication, so we have a safe return to campus.

We will be starting on-campus instruction Monday, Jan. 24th. Please take time to carefully read this communication because there are many important points to know and some actions you will need to take:

- **All students and staff must present the following to return to campus**

- a negative PCR or antigen COVID test no more than 72 hrs. before Monday start
- a positive PCR or antigen COVID test demonstrating you had COVID within the last 90 days but not within the last 10 days.

Friday, Jan. 21 – PCR testing services on-campus: We will provide testing services at school from 1:00-4:00 p.m. in the cafeteria. Please fill out this [LINK](#) to sign up for an appointment time.

- **Please check the list (in previous email) to see if your insurance is accepted by the laboratory.** If not, but you still decide to do it at school, the cost of the test will be \$50 to be paid at the time of testing.
- **Bring form filled out, copy of your ID, and copy of your insurance card.**
- **GREEN FORMS REQUIRED:** All students who do not have their Green Form of non-COVID vaccinations up-to-date will not be allowed to enter school on Jan. 24th. Various reminders have been sent, including a message regarding this deadline.
- **Monday, Jan. 24 = Staggered Start to confirm Test and Green Form compliance**
 - 7:20-8:00 a.m. = Upper School (with Lower School siblings)
 - 8:00-8:45 a.m. = Lower School
- **Cafeteria will still serve breakfast and lunch.**
- **Snacks and beverages will NOT be sold** from the vending machines or cafeteria, so please bring from home. Please send your child with enough water for the day, especially those days in which she/he has PE.
- **UPCOMING and MODIFIED CALENDAR DATES**
 - **Jan. 31 – Feb. 4: New MAP Testing Week** – This will allow students to return to campus, settle in, and in elementary receive some practice preparation before the test.
 - Jan. 27: Admissions Open House: Please spread the word
 - **Feb. 10-11: These will be regular full day of classes**
 - Feb. 21: President's Day (Closed)
 - Feb. 16: Lower School Parent-Teacher Conferences
 - Feb. 17: Upper School Parent-Teacher Conferences
 - **Feb. 15: Deadline for 12+ to present evidence of COVID booster vaccination to our school nurse**
